Residential development site in a lovely rural secluded setting on Strathmore Golf Course. Expired planning consent for 6 units, available as a whole or as separate serviced plots.

The plots are being sold as serviced plots with the purchaser paying £5,000 towards these costs. Each plot sold will be subject to the purchaser securing planning consent using the seller's architect. The design brief will confirm the range of architectural styles and materials which each house can be built to. The overall aim is to allow each buyer to construct a bespoke home, but one which fits well within the setting and in relation to the neighbouring properties.

Timescales for the servicing of each plot will be confirmed shortly. Full settlement of the purchase price is required fourteen days after services are installed.

Plots can be reserved upon payment of a £500 deposit. A missive is then issued and a further payment of £500 is made. The £1,000 is deducted from the overall sale price of the plot.

SITUATION

Leroch Farm Steading is located in a secluded spot at the west side of Strathmore Golf Course and within close proximity of the villages of Alyth and New Alyth in the district of Perthshire.

The steading is within a few hundred yards of the Strathmore Golf Course bar & restaurant and within walking distance of the Blackbird Inn, New Alyth and Alyth itself.

Strathmore golf course lies 2.7 miles south of Alyth and 6.4 miles from Blairgowrie. There are 3 other golf courses within 4 miles and 3 courses at Blairgowrie, including a 9 hole course. Glenshee ski resort is 30 miles away.







DIRECTIONS

From Dundee head northwest up the A923 Coupar Angus Road toward Birkhill/Muirhead. At Muirhead the road forks in 2 right after "Adil's Convenience Store". Continue down the right fork which is the B954. Continue for approximately 8 miles passing through Auchterhouse & Newtyle before reaching Meigle. Continue through Meigle and just after you leave the village turn right up the B954 and continue for approximately 1.3 miles and then turn left towards Netherton Montessori Nursery School. After approximately 0.5 miles the road will fork to the right and then to the left. Continue for another half mile and turn right. After 0.3 miles you will see the Strathmore Golf Centre on your right. Turn left and Leroch Farm Steading is situated at the end of the road.

From Perth head north up the A94 for 17 miles passing through Scone, Balbeggie, Burrelton and Coupar Angus. Approximately 2.5 miles past Coupar Angus turn left and continue for 1.8 miles until you reach a T junction. Turn right and continue for approximately 0.9 miles until you reach a crossroads. Turn right and continue for 0.3 miles until you see the Strathmore Golf Centre on your right. Turn left and Leroch Farm Steading is situated at the end of the road.
